What:

The Black Desert Championship, one of three new additions to the 2025 LPGA schedule, marks the LPGA Tour's historic return to Utah after 60 years, following the 1964 Riverside Ladies Open at Riverside Country Club in Provo. Boasting a \$3 million purse, the tournament ranks among the higher-tier payouts on the LPGA Tour, emphasizing its dedication to celebrating women's golf and delivering a world-class tournament experience.

Sustainability:

Creating a sustainable water usage plan was central to Black Desert Resort's planning efforts, including the Black Desert Golf Course. The course uses the newest cultivars of permanent turfgrass species that are bred to be the most drought and heat tolerant available, also eliminating the need to overseed and saves water by reducing the need to be continuously reestablished. The use of organic fertilizers, integrated pest management, aerification, and wetting agents are used extensively to reduce water usage and soil tests are completed yearly to ensure soil structure and mineral make-up are adequate to hold water and disperse water to a robust root system. The golf course's irrigation

system is the most modern and high-tech option available, allowing the agronomy team to provide the exact amount of water needed in each area of the course, which can be adjusted based on rainfall and other environmental conditions, reducing over-watering and waste.
